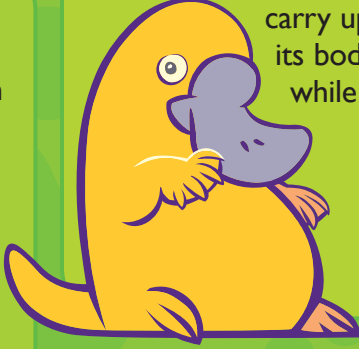




Wacky Facts

- D) A butterfly can carry up to 50 times its body weight while in flight.

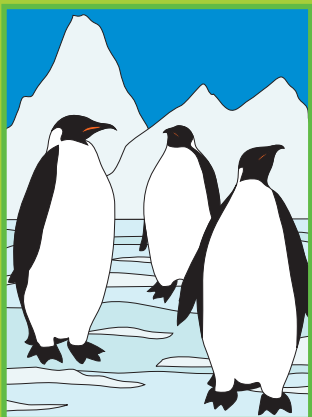

THE COOLEST PLACE ON EARTH!

Antarctica is the coldest place on earth! It has a record low of -129° F (-54°C). Strangely enough Antarctica also holds records as being both the wettest and driest place on the planet! It is the wettest because more than 98% of it is covered in ice. The ice is thickest at Wilkes Land where it is 15,699 feet (about three miles) deep! However, Antarctica is also



the driest place on earth because it receives less than two inches of rain in a year. This is about the same amount of rainfall that the Sahara Desert receives. One part of Antarctica, known as the Dry Valleys, hasn't received rain in over 2 million years! Because it is so cold and dry, Antarctica is used by space programs to train astronauts before they go into outer space! Talk about a COOL place!

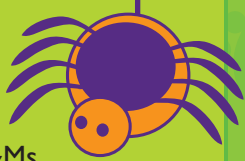

Try This Out!

CREEPY CRAWLY COOKIES

Please ask an adult for help!
You'll need:

- 2 Chocolate wafer cookies
- Chocolate frosting
- Mini chocolate chips or M&Ms
- Black lace licorice



Preparation:

- Spread the chocolate frosting on one side of each cookie.
- Cut a piece of licorice into 8 pieces about 2 - 3 inches long.
- Put the licorice on the frosting on one of the cookies so they look like the spider's legs sticking out (4 sticking out on each side).
- Then put the other cookie, frosting side down, on top of it to hold the "spider legs" in place.
- Using the frosting as your "glue" add 2 eyes using the chocolate chips or M&Ms and enjoy!
